CONTINUING EDUCATION INFORMATION

The Education Department is a provider for Nursing, Respiratory Therapy, Radiology, Social Work, and Laboratory continuing education.

The Education team coordinates in-service and continuing education programs including clinical orientation, IV therapy classes, PowerChart training, Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers, Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS), Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS), and annual in-services.

During a two-year licensure period, nurses are required to earn 24 contact hours including one hour of HIV/AIDS during your first 2-year licensure cycle. A 2-hour course on Domestic Violence is required every third renewal cycle of six years. A 2-hour course on Preventing Medical Errors is required every licensure cycle. The se courses must be obtained from a Florida Board of Nursing approved provider. All licensees are subject to audit. If audited, the nurse must submit copies of certificates of attendance to the Florida Board of Nursing as proof of participation in appropriate continuing education. Hours must be earned within the renewal period and certificates must be maintained for 4 years.

All continuing education completed at FHMMC is entered into the CE Broker online database per Florida statute.

CNAs are required to complete 18 in service hours per calendar year.



NetLearning (NL) is our computer-based learning system for completion of mandatory requirements, continuing education programs and general in-service credits. A CBL (computer-based learning module) can be accessed from any PC at home or at work.

To utilize NetLearning on your unit PC, click on the internet explorer icon. Then, click on NetLearning in the "I Need to Access" box.

To access NL from home:

- 1 - Click on your Internet Explorer icon.
- 2 - Type in www.floridahospitalmemorial.org
- 3 - Click on "Employees" (on top right).
- 4 - Click on the "NetLearning" link.
- 5 - Enter your Destiny ID.

Completions: Information about courses you have completed.

Enroll in CBL: A list of all unassigned online courses available. You can enroll in online courses and launch them immediately or add them to your To Do list.

Enroll in Class: A list of all unassigned instructor-led courses available. You can enroll in a class at a selected time and location. (Pre-requisite CBLs may be required before enrolling in a class.) The class then moves to your To Do list.

Certificates for CBLs: CBLs that are approved for continuing education have a link for printing certificates on the Completions page.
